WHO WE ARE



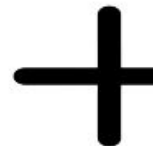

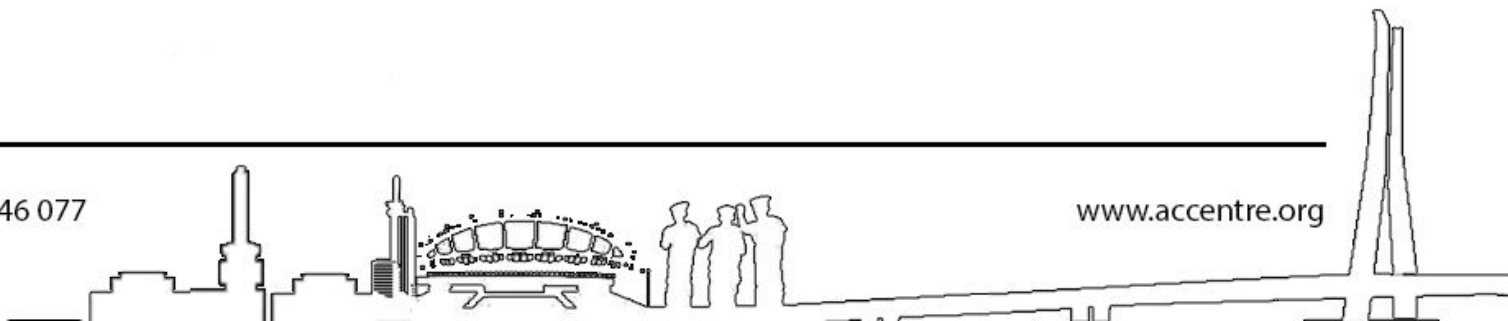
